WINEMAKER NOTES

The Stepskis, Central European nobles, even before crossing their destinies with those of the Rechsteiner family, had discovered the attraction for the Serenissima and its lands. Felix Moritz Stepski-Doliwa, the Austro-Hungarian garrison leader, had decided to create a refreshment post for his soldiers and officers in Venice. There is still a trace of this in the sign Sandwirth, or "sand host", which decorates the front door of the Hotel Gabrielli in Venice. In 1881, Friederich Rechsteiner took over from the Revedin counts the estate and the seventeenth-century Villa of Piavon di Oderzo, which originally belonged to the Bonamico family and before that to Cardinal Ottoboni. Even today, the farm is run by a direct descendant of the founder: Baron Florian von Stepski-Doliwa, great-grandson of Friederich's youngest daughter who married a Stepski.

TASTING NOTES

Color: pale cherry pink. Bouquet: elegant with notes of apple, pear and ripe red fruits. Fresh and crunchy on the palate, well-balanced acidity, persistent perlage. Pairings: aperitif, shellfish and sushi
