WINEMAKER NOTES

I Montali is a result of a special selection made in the cellar by Enrico during the bleeding phase. Montali combines the freshness of Encrico's Poggio with the elegance and structure of Montepergoli.

TASTING NOTES

Notes of dark fruits and mocha - warm, generous mouthfeel, with elegant polished tannins. Sensuous and enveloping on the palate.

VINEYARD

- **DOC:** Bolgheri Rosso
- **Soil:** Mixed sand and clay
- **Exposition:** East to South-West
- **Altitude:** 70-80 meters above sea level

VINIFICATION

The grapes were vinified separately with maceration taking place over 3 to 4 weeks in temperature controlled conditions. Following fermentation, the wine remained for nearly 12 months in small French oak barrels.

TASTING NOTES

Intense red color with smoky violet hues. Clean, focused aromas of black fruit accompanied by toasted oak. Great intensity and harmonious on the palate; rich with layers of flavors, concentrated with generous tannins.

VINIFICATION

The grapes were carefully selected and vinified separately, maceration taking place over a period of 20 – 28 days. Temperature controlled fermentation. The wine remained for 18 months in French oak barriques followed by additional aging in bottle for one year prior to being released.

TASTING NOTES

A powerful red, packed with black cherry, blackberry and plum flavors, featuring vibrant acidity. Firmly structured, with tannins that resonate on the finish, offset by sweet fruit and underbrush notes.

VINEYARD

The vineyards are located in the Bolgheri region of Toscana, where the clayey and calcareous soil components and the micro-climate help shape the grapes. The weather is Mediterranean, yet cool with the grapes ripening at the end of September.

VINIFICATION

The grapes were vinified separately with maceration taking place over 3 to 4 weeks in temperature controlled conditions. Fermentation took place on indigenous yeast at controlled temperature 25 to 30 degrees C in stainless steel tanks. Following fermentation, the wine remained for nearly three months in small French oak barrels. Further refinement in bottle before being released.
